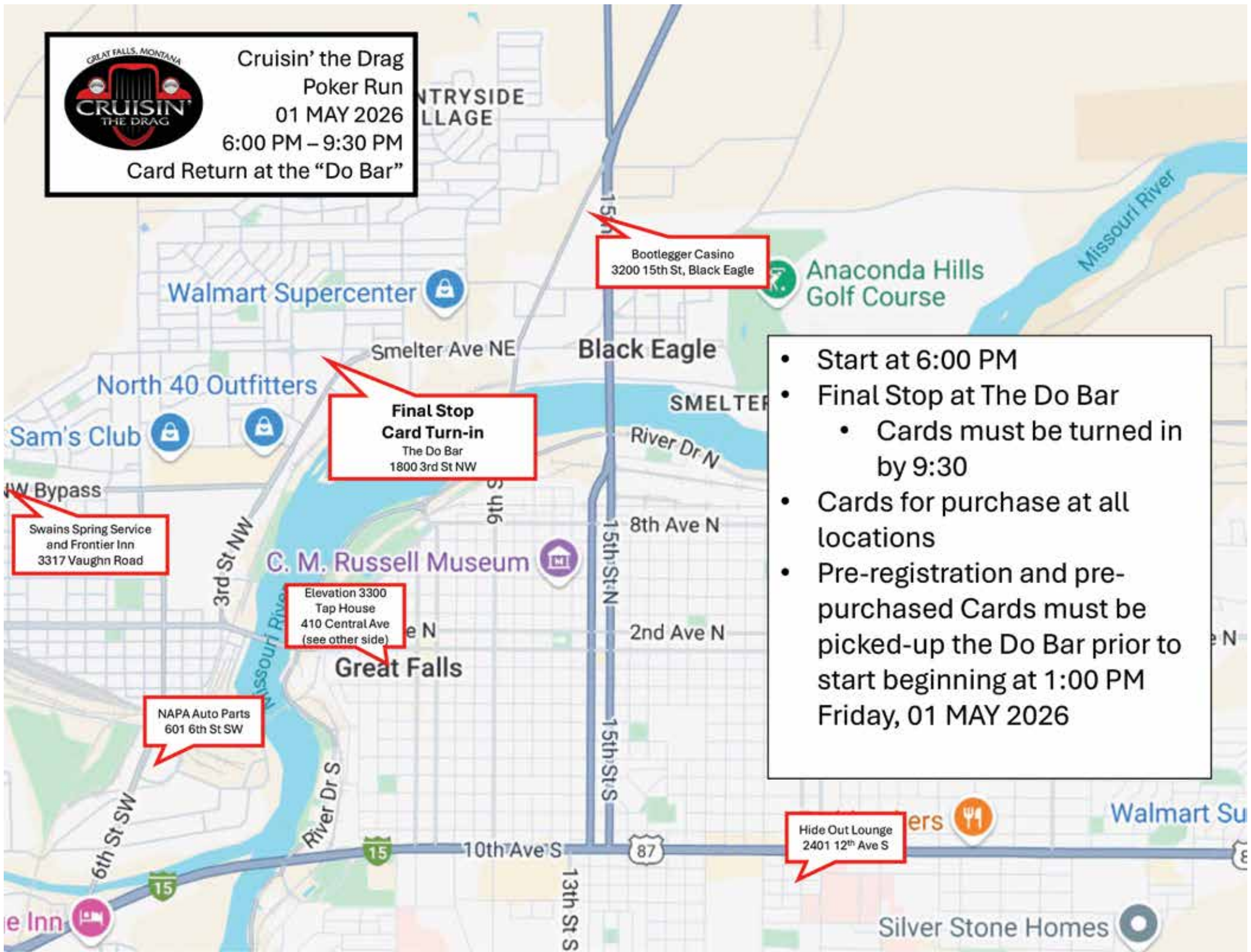

Poker Chip Run Rules

1. Chips will be picked at the designated stops on the Poker Run route. PLAYERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PICK CHIPS FOR ALL CARDS PLAYED AT ONE STOP. Chips will be picked one at a time and laid number up on the table for review by Cruisin' The Drag staff.
2. If playing more than one hand, the player must present all additional Chip Run cards/hands, in the order that the participant wishes the chips to be drawn.
3. A total of four (4) mulligan chips can be drawn per hand, per stop, for \$5.00 each. The Mulligan replaces a chip drawn at that stop for the card being played. The forfeited chip will be placed back in the bag prior to drawing another Mulligan Chip. The chip numbers that are forfeited by the player will be written on the card and crossed out. The final and accepted chip will be circled.
4. Players must turn in their cards at The Do Bar no later than the 9:30pm deadline, or they forfeit their chances to win.
5. In the case of a tie, there will be a draw for the highest chip to determine the winner.
6. Players MUST BE PRESENT to receive any winnings.
7. All decisions of the judges are FINAL.

Car Show Rules

1. No Burnouts - we all love them, but this isn't the time or place for them. There are too many people and too many cars. This is a directive from the city, police will be on patrol, and it is a ticketable violation.
2. Respect Our Volunteers - This is a zero-tolerance issue. You will be removed from the venue. These gracious people are kind enough to help our community with this exciting event. Please extend them the respect they deserve.
3. Parking - We will direct you to your parking spot when you arrive at the venue. Please follow the instructions from our parking staff while parking. We need to make room for everyone, and this will help ensure we have enough space for everyone.
4. No parking on sidewalks or corner outcroppings - This is a directive from the city.
5. No Fighting - This is a zero-tolerance issue. You will be asked to leave.
6. Respect the Cars - if it's not yours, DO NOT touch it. Watch your children around the cars. If you see an issue, please let one of our staff know.
7. Keep our community beautiful - please pick up after yourself.
